- All Classes - \$15/Class/Judge      \*Regional Classes - \$12/Class      \*Leadline - Free
- NSBA Classes – \$10/Judge/Class (not included in the flat fee)
- AQHA Administration Fee - \$8/horse/judge (not included in the flat fee)
- Office Fee /Split Combine - \$12/Judge
- Obstacle Fee - \$30 (not included in the flat fee)
- Grounds Fee (showing out of trailer) - \$25/day – NO day stalls are available
- Stalls - \$140 (see website [www.aqhar6.com](http://www.aqhar6.com) for reservations forms)
- Tack Stalls - \$140 – (Due to accounting difficulties there will not be any splitting of bills on tack stalls, must be on 1 show bill)
